The Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA) conducts its annual flagship programme called the Advanced Professional Programme in Public Administration (APPPA). This is a long term education-cum-training programme which is specifically designed for senior officers of the All India/Central Services and Defense Services generally of the rank of Joint Secretary in the Central Government and equivalent in the State Governments. The programme is sponsored by the Department of Personnel and Training (DOPT), Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Government of India and is financially supported by the various Ministries that sponsor the officers. The ongoing programme, which commenced on July 3, 2017, is the 43rd in the series and forty seven officers are participating in it.

2. An important component of the programme is the *village study*, which is scheduled to be conducted from **November 6 to 11th, 2017** in different regions of the country. The purpose of the village study is to sensitize the participants to the socio-economic conditions of the people in the rural areas, particularly those below the poverty line and to get direct insights regarding the development programmes running in rural areas such as MGNREGA, NRLM/SGSY, Mission *Antyodaya*, PMAY, SBM, PMKVY, NRHM, RTE/ SSA etc. and their implementation.

3. For the purpose of the study, a group of 18 participants (**list enclosed**), accompanied by a faculty advisor will visit Ghaziabad and Baghpat districts of Uttar Pradesh. The visit will also provide the participants with the opportunity to discuss development-related problems with the functionaries of Panchayati Raj Institutions and other local level agencies. They will meet senior functionaries at the block and district levels, visit facilities/ infrastructure created under these programs and directly interact with people/ beneficiaries in the villages.

4. We would be grateful if you could kindly advise the District Magistrates/ Deputy Commissioners of Ghaziabad and Baghpat -districts selected for the study – to help in the selection of two villages in each district for the study i.e., one village where rural development schemes are working well and have made most progress and another village where progress has been slower. A visit to a local NGO that is doing creditable work in the respective districts will also be helpful.
